physically, intellectually, and mentally..

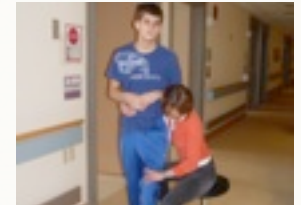
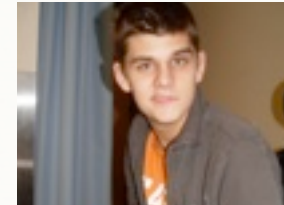
