What I learn and use today

******1st Impression******

Introduce self and role. Not loud.

Inviting, concerned, maintain eye contact, attentive. Do not talk down. (24 yrs old = 24 yrs old)

****** Do not take personally******

If non-compliant/agitated come back later or with someone who has established rapport.

****** Be goal directed******

Patient's first

****** Be consistent******

From interactions to transfers

****** Respect family******

Educate and understand

****** Respect Consent******

Give reasoning

****** Respect each other******

Accept feedback. If one is successful, all can be.

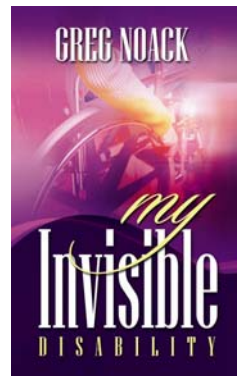
