A local expert panel will provide their perspective on providing these standards in Windsor & Essex County.

Goals of the Workshop:

- Understand and consider how to apply the 15 criteria from the standards to guide interdisciplinary clinics and healthcare providers in processes used to provide care to individuals with concussion/mTBI from MVC, falls, assaults, etc.
- Learn how to help patients ask the best questions around how their care is delivered.
- Update on management of persistent symptoms of concussion in individuals sustained in falls, motor vehicle collisions and assaults.
- How to rely on evidence based practice to strengthen treatment programming and plans of care to facilitate funding.
- Opportunity to network and exchange ideas for best practice.

Who Should Attend:

- Health care providers across the continuum of care who provide work with individuals post-concussion (nurses, OT, OTA, PT, PTA, SLP, social workers, psychologists, case managers, rehab workers, physicians, etc.)
- Non-treatment professionals working with individuals post-concussion (lawyers, insurers, admin. Assistants, educators, etc.)
